According to the No Child Left Behind Act, your child is eligible to receive Supplemental Education Services in either English Language Arts or Mathematics. Eligible students are those students who meet specific income guidelines (qualify for free and/or reduced lunch) and who attend a school designated by the State Education Department as a “School in Need of Improvement.”

Supplemental Education Services are tutoring services. Supplemental Education Service Providers are state-approved vendors who deliver these services.
