

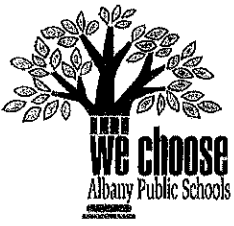

Dear Parent or Guardian:

As you may know, Philip Schuyler Achievement Academy will be affected by the new state “receivership” law designed to improve student performance. The law applies to 144 New York schools that the state has identified as “struggling” or “persistently struggling,” including Schuyler, Albany High School and William S. Hackett Middle School in our school district.

Schuyler Achievement Academy has been designated as a “struggling” school. Schools on this list have two years to show progress, beginning with the 2015-16 school year. Schuyler was identified because its overall student performance on state tests that measure English and math skills significantly lagged behind other schools in the state for more than three years.

**On Aug. 11, I will conduct a public hearing at Schuyler Achievement Academy at 5:30 p.m. to discuss in greater detail how the state determined that Schuyler is a “struggling” school and what receivership means for the school’s future. The meeting will be held in the gym.**

The law designates that, as the superintendent, I initially will be the receiver for Schuyler. I will work with your new principal and the Schuyler community to meet and exceed expectations and best practices outlined in the new law. Opportunities include:

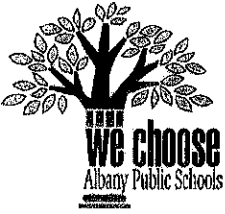
- Becoming a community school providing additional student and family services
- Extending the school day or year
- Changes to curriculum
- Re-staffing

We will continue to bolster after-school programs and extended-day learning opportunities. In addition, we are in the process of creating a Community Engagement Team – also required by the new law – that will develop recommendations for improvement of the schools and solicit feedback. If the school does not show sufficient improvement in two years, the state will require our Board of Education to appoint a state-approved outside receiver, removing our ability to control future decisions about Schuyler.

We don’t have all the answers yet and are working closely with the State Education Department for details. I will keep you informed as we receive more information, and look forward to talking with you more about what receivership will mean for Schuyler at our Aug. 11 meeting.

Estimados padres y tutores:

Como ustedes saben, Philip Schuyler Achievement Academy se verá afectada por la nueva ley estatal "receivership" que está diseñada para mejorar el desempeño de los estudiantes. La ley se aplica a 144 escuelas de Nueva York que el estado ha identificado como "struggling" (con dificultades) o "persistently struggling" (con dificultades persistentes) incluyendo Schuyler, Albany High, y William S. Hackett Middle School en nuestro distrito escolar.

Philip Schuyler Achievement Academy ha sido designada como escuela "struggling" (con dificultades). Escuelas en esta lista tienen dos años para demostrar progreso, empezando con el año escolar 2015-16. Schuyler se identificó porque el desempeño de los estudiantes ha disminuido significativamente comparado con escuelas en el estado por más de tres años, según el desempeño general de los estudiantes en los exámenes estatales que miden las habilidades de matemáticas e Inglés.

**El 11 de Agosto, conduciré una audiencia pública en Schuyler Achievement Academy at 5:30 p.m. para discutir a detalle cómo el estado determinó que Schuyler es una escuela "struggling" (con dificultades) y qué es lo que "receivership" significa para el futuro de la escuela. La reunión se llevará a cabo en el gimnasio.**

La ley determina, que como el superintendente, yo seré el destinatario para Schuyler. Voy a trabajar con Schuyler y la comunidad para alcanzar y exceder las expectativas y mejores prácticas descritas en la nueva ley. Oportunidades incluyen:

- Convertirse en una escuela comunitaria que provee servicios adicionales a los estudiantes y sus familias
- Extender el día escolar o el año escolar
- Cambiar el currículo
- Nuevo personal

Continuaremos impulsando los programas vespertinos y los programas de día extendido de oportunidad de aprender. Adicionalmente, estamos en el proceso de crear un equipo de participación comunitaria –también requerido por la ley estatal– que desarrollará recomendaciones para mejorar las escuelas y solicitar sugerencias. Si la escuela no muestra suficientes mejoras en dos años, el estado va a requerir que nuestro Comité Directivo nombre a un destinatario externo aprobado por el estado, removiendo nuestra habilidad de controlar decisiones futuras sobre Schuyler.

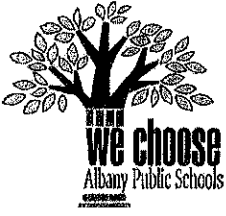

Philip Schuyler Achievement Academy သည်အပြင်းအထန်ကြိုးစားအားထုတ်ရသောကျောင်းကဲ့သို့ သတ်မှတ်ခြင်းခံရ သည်။ စာရင်းထဲပါရှိသောကျောင်းများသည် 2015-16 စာသင်နှစ်မှစတင်ပြီး ၂ နှစ်အတွင်း တိုးတက်လာသည့်အခြေအနေများ ဖော်ပြရ မည်။ Schuyler ကျောင်းအားဖော်ပြခံရသည့်အကြောင်းရင်းမှာ ကျောင်းသားများ အားပြည်နယ်စာမေးပွဲ အကဲဖြတ်ရာတွင် အင်္ဂလိပ် နှင့် သင်္ချာဘာသာ ကျွမ်းကျင်မှုများသည် အခြားကျောင်းများနှင့် ၃ နှစ်ထက် နောက်နေ့ ခြင်းဖြစ်သည်။

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## اختيارنا كان على مدارس مقاطعة "البناني"

الالتزام بمستوى الإمتياز

أعزائنا الآباء والأمهات / أولياء الأمور

( سنتأثر بالقانون الجديد المتعلق بتسليم الأموال المعتمدة في الولاية والذي William S. Hackett كما تعلمون، أن مدرسة وليام س. هاكيت الإعدادية ) يسعى إلى تحسين أداء الطلبة. هذا القانون سنتأثر به (144) مدرسة من مدارس ولاية نيويورك من التي تم تصديقها بأنها مدارس "تعاني" أو "تعاني بشكل مستمر" ( William S. Hackett Middle School ) ووليام س. هاكيت الإعدادية (Albany High School) من تنلي مستوى الأداء ومنها مدارس "البناني الثانوية، ( Philip Schuyler Achievement Academy ) ومدرسة فيليب شويلر الأكاديمية ) في مقاطعتنا.

لقد تم تصنيف إعدادية هاكيت على أنها "تعاني بشكل مستمر". ومدارس تلك القائمة عندها مدة سنتين لتثبت أنها تحقق بعض التقدم اعتباراً من العام الدراسي 2015-2016. وقد وردت المدرسة في هذا التصنيف نظراً لأن مستوى الطلاب المتخرجين منها كان دون المدارس الأخرى على مدى أكثر من العشر سنوات الماضية أو أكثر.

في (12) الثاني عشر من أغسطس الساعة السادسة مساءً سيكون هناك ندوة عامة للبحث وإعطاء التفاصيل عما جاء في ترتيب المدرسة على أنها "تعاني بشكل مستمر" وكذلك بحث تسليم الدعم المالي وماذا يعني هذا لمستقبل المدرسة. الاجتماع سيكون في المدرج.

القانون يعني أنه، بصفتي المشرف على المدرسة، فإنني سأكون المسئوم لهذا الدعم وسأعمل مع مدير المدرسة مايكل باولينو واللجنة التابعة للمنطقة لتقديم الدعم وما يفوق التوقعات للتوصل إلى أفضل النتائج التي ينص عليها القانون. من المواضيع التي سيتم بحثها:

- كيف تستطيع المدرسة توفير خدمات أفضل للطلاب والعائلات؛
- تمديد أيام السنة الدراسية؛
- تغييرات في المناهج؛
- زيادة عدد الموظفين.

سنستمر في دعم برامج ساعات الدراسة بعد الدوام الرسمي وفرص التعليم الأفضل. إضافة إلى ذلك، فإننا في صدد تشكيل لجنة من المجتمع للمشاركة، حسبما ينظله القانون الجديد، لإعطاء توصيات جديدة لتطوير المدرسة وإعطاء الإرشادات والنصح لما يمكن عمله. وفي حال فشلت المدرسة في إثبات التقدم المرجو خلال سنة، فإن الولاية ستطلب من المجلس التعليمي تعيين مسئوم جديد توافق عليه الولاية لتلك الأموال، وهذا يعني عدم تمكننا من إعطاء أي قرار مستقبلي في التحكم بهذا الرصيد أو اتخاذ أي قرار عن مدرسة هاكيت.

ليس عندنا إجابات على جميع الأسئلة بعد ولكننا نعمل بشكل وثيق مع المجلس التعليمي في الولاية على التفاصيل. سأعمل على مدكم بالمعلومات أولاً بأول عن توفير واستلام هذا الدعم في اجتماعنا القادم في الثاني عشر من أغسطس القادم.
