## INTRODUCTION:

Albany High Summer School is an accredited program offering secondary level instruction for all students in the City of Albany and its surrounding areas.

**Due to renovations at the Albany High School, this year's summer classes will be held at Hackett Middle School.**

## ATTENDANCE:

As per the district attendance policy, students who **exceed three unexcused absences** will not receive credit for summer courses. Students must provide written proof within four school days of the absence for it to be excused.

## STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

Students are expected to attend all of the scheduled days of instruction. All students are expected to be prepared for class every day. All students are expected to visibly display their school identification at all times. Students who are more than five (5) minutes late for class will not be allowed into the building until the beginning of the next period. Students are expected to dress appropriately for school. Shirts and shoes are to be worn at all times.

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

The summer school Registration/Permission form is located in your guidance office. No student can register without an accurately completed permission form signed by the student's guidance counselor. Deadline for all registration is June 30, 2011.

## REVIEW SESSIONS FOR REGENTS COURSES:

Review sessions will be held from August 1st through August 16th, between 12:30 to 2:30 p.m. A schedule of each review class will be mailed to students who register to take an exam. Additionally, review schedules will be available in the summer school office on: July 21, 2011.

## Summer School Rules

The first day of summer school is on Tuesday, July 5, 2011 classes will begin promptly at 8:00am. Due to security procedures, students should arrive 15 minutes early to school to allow enough time to complete security screening process and to ensure their arrival on time for class. By following the procedures listed below, students should have a successful summer school experience:

1. Students are expected to bring books, writing utensils, notebooks and other school supplies every day.
2. Students who are more than 5 minutes late for class will not be allowed in the building.
3. Student identification cards are created at the time of registration. **Students are required to VISIBLY** display their school identification at all times.
4. Students will not be allowed to loiter in the halls. All students must have a pass in their possession when they are in the hall.
5. Proper attire is expected of all students. No gang affiliated clothing, no plunging necklines, short skirts or short shorts. If you are dressed inappropriately you will be sent home.
6. Electronic devices (i-pods, music devices, cell phones, etc. **are not** allowed in the building. **Please do not bring them to school.**
7. The summer school staff will not be responsible for lost or stolen property in or around the building (including bicycles).
8. Students will receive a participation grade based on their daily attendance and class assignments.
9. Hackett Middle School is a smoke-free campus, per state law: smoking will not be allowed.
10. Food and beverages are **not** allowed in the building.
