SUMMER RECONSTRUCTION PROJECTS  
(Prioritization)**

RESOLVED: All proposed Capital Reconstruction Projects be presented to the Board of Education one month before their approval is needed. The first appearance on the agenda will be for the purpose of discussion only. Architects and other district personnel should be in attendance to answer any questions from the board. The second appearance on the agenda, one month later, will be for the purpose of approving or disapproving the projects.

All proposed Capital Reconstruction Projects presented to the Board of Education shall be prioritized according to the following criteria:

Priority I – Urgent: The proposed project would eliminate a serious threat to the health or safety of students and employees or it would correct conditions which threaten the structural integrity of the building which would require more costly repairs at a later date. These projects should be done immediately.

Priority 2 – Needed: The proposed project would enhance the health and safety of students and staff or contribute to a more efficient operation of the building. Those projects could be delayed for a year or two with no serious problems.

Priority 3 – Desirable: The proposed project would improve the appearance of the building and enhance the learning/work environment. These projects could be delayed indefinitely without serious problems.
