

Giffen School Supply List

1. Please label supplies with your child's name.
2. A book bag/backpack large enough to carry notebooks and a pair of sneakers to and from school.
3. Materials need to be available each day for the students to use.
4. Parents/students are responsible for replenishing supplies.
5. Please do not send trapper keepers or stiff binders to school – they do not fit in the desks. Children may use flexible binders.

All students in prekindergarten through 6 are required to wear sneakers for gym class. Please be sure your child is prepared for gym class. Sneakers should be worn to school on the days your child's class has gym.

Prekindergarten – Mrs. Giorgio:

- 2 – marble notebooks (hard cover black/white)

- 2 – folders (any color or picture)
- 6 – colored folders (1 of each; red, blue, green, purple, orange, yellow)
- 1 – pencil box
- 4 – packs of #2 pencils
- 1 – box of crayons
- 1 – pack of loose leaf filler paper
- 2 – yellow highlighters
- 1 – back pack
- 2- boxes of tissues
- 1 – bottle of glue
- 1 – pack of glue sticks
- 1 – child scissors

Fifth Grade – Mr. Dudley/Mrs. Walker and Mrs. Dobson:

- 1 – sturdy book bag
- 5 – notebooks (1 of each color; yellow, red, blue, green, purple)
- 6 – folders (1 of each color; yellow, red, blue, green, purple, 1 of your choice for homework)
- 1 – composition notebook
- 2 – pencils everyday (a suggestion is to stock up while they are on sale)
- 1 – box of tissues
- 2 – packs of loose leaf paper
- Crayons / colored pencils (optional)

We also highly recommend a 512mb or larger Flash Drive/USB Drive so the students can save their work as school and work on it in another location (home, library, etc.). They can be purchased for as little as \$9.99. This will give your child the opportunity to extend their learning and maximize their success.

Please do not send in 3-ring binders or hard plastic pencil cases because they will not fit in the desks.
