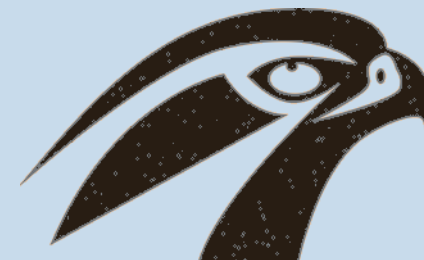

## OTHER DISTRICT STUDENTS

## IMPORTANT INFO

The first day of summer school is Thursday, July 5. Classes begin promptly at 8 a.m. Students should arrive 15 minutes early to allow enough time to complete the security screening process and ensure their on-time arrival in class.

- Every student will receive a bus pass at registration. This pass will be valid for the duration of summer school.
- Students who are more than five minutes late for any class may not be allowed in the building until the beginning of the next period.
- Please be prepared for class. Students should bring books, writing utensils, notebooks and other needed supplies.
- Please bring your current Albany High School ID with you. Students must VISIBLY display their school ID all times.
- Students will not be allowed to loiter in the halls. All students must have a pass when they are in the hallways.
- Students will receive a participation grade based on daily attendance and class assignments.
- Proper attire is expected of all students. No gang-affiliated clothing, no plunging necklines, tube tops, short skirts or short shorts. If you are inappropriately dressed, you may be sent home.
- Electronic device usage (iPods, music devices, cell phones, etc.) is up to teacher discretion. Devices should not be a distraction to instruction.
- Summer school is not responsible for property stolen in or around school, including bicycles.
