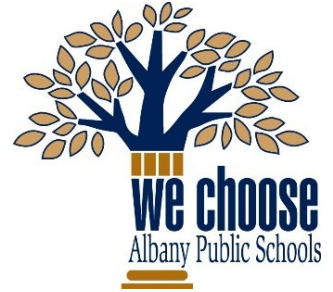
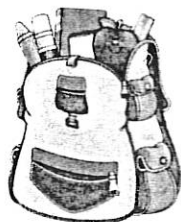
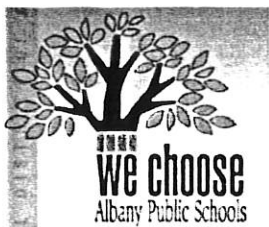

Student Needs:

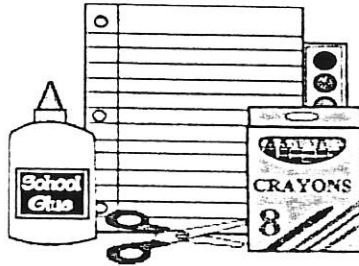
- Backpack (standard size, no wheels) – Labeled with your child's name

- 2 – durable 2 pocket folders
- Family pictures *Please label with your child's name all "Student Needs"

Some items may need to be replaced during the school year. Please keep an eye out for notes sent home! Thank you for your support ☺

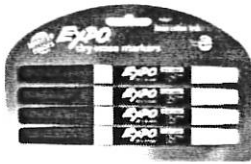
Welcome to Kindergarten...

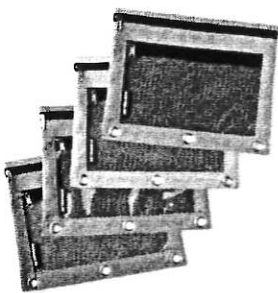
First Grade Supply List

The following items are the supplies needed for classroom use:

- 1 regular size backpack (**no minis please**)
- 1 composition notebook (**no spirals please**)
- 1 zippered pencil pouch **with clear plastic window on top of netting (see picture below)**
- 20 #2 pencils (**only regular yellow pencils please**—no colors or designs)
- 1 pair of Fiskars brand blunt tip scissors
- 2 boxes of Crayola brand crayons (16 or 24 count)
- 6 folders pocket folders (2 of each color) red, yellow, blue
- 1 Homework Folder (any school appropriate design)
- 1 bottles Elmer's glue (liquid...see picture below)
- 12 Elmer's glue sticks (see picture below)
- 2 or 3 pack of pink erasers (see picture below)
- 4 **black** dry erase markers (see picture below)
- 2 full-size boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 container Lysol or Clorox wipes
- If your **last name starts with A-N** 1 box of **gallon size zip lock bags**
- If your **last name starts with O-Z** 1 box of **quart size zip lock bags**
- ***Mrs. Loomis' class only 1 plain white 1inch 3-ring binder

All supplies listed above, except the backpack and homework folder, will be kept/used at school.

Students must also have crayons, scissors, glue, pencils (in addition to the above supplies) and a pencil sharpener at home so they can complete nightly homework assignments.

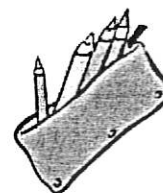
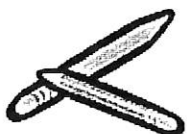
The following items are the supplies needed for your child to be successful this school year:

- 2 black/white wide-ruled composition books
- 48 No. 2 pencils
- 1 pencil box
- 2 boxes of crayons (24 count each)
- 1 package of pencil top erasers
- 3 large boxes of tissues
- 3-one subject notebook (colors needed: green, red, and yellow)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 pair of kid scissors
- 4 folders with pockets (colors needed: yellow, green, red, and blue)
- 1 Homework Folder (any school appropriate design)
- 5 glue sticks (no bottles please)
- 1 box ziplock bags (sandwich, quart or gallon)
- 4 highlighters
- 8 Expo Dry Erase Markers

***If you prefer, you may send in \$10 the first week of school and we can provide your child with their supplies.**

Students **must** have crayons, scissors, glue, pencils and a sharpener at home so they can complete nightly homework assignment. Keeping a pencil box at home will help ensure homework success. Your child will also need a backpack large enough to hold their homework and books. **All supplies will be kept in school.** While supplies are on sale it is a good idea to get extra notebooks and folders in case your child works through theirs.
