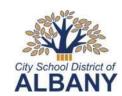
Bid Status



- Competitive Bids for All Contracts
 - Sitework 5 bidders (Phases 1 and 2: 2-3 bidders)
 - General Construction 6 bidders (Phases 1 and 2: 3-5 bidders)
 - Plumbing 4 bidders (Phases 1 and 2: 3-4 bidders
 - Mechanical 4 bidders (Phases 1 and 2: 5-8 bidders)
 - Electrical 5 bidders (Phases 1 and 2: 3 bidders)
 - Fire Protection 2 bidders (Phases 1 and 2: 2 bidders)
- Impact of COVID-19 no specifically defined cost impact
- Bids are over the allocated budget but feel that they are very competitive for the scope
 - Details will be reviewed later in the presentation



Previous Scope Modifications



Realigned scope

- Little theater
- Renovation of existing music rooms under the auditorium into specific theater support spaces
- Significant locker room renovations
- Relocated security office area
- Reduced front lobby and dedicated art gallery space including eliminating open stair between the auditorium lobby and the balcony access
- Reuse existing elevator in existing classroom building instead of building a new one
- Leave space for second floor team rooms as just open rooms. No toilet or special finishes
- Simplify exterior wall materials and detailing. Change type of masonry and use more ribbed metal panels
- Modify detailing of auditorium ceiling and acoustic treatments
- Change to vinyl composition tile in hallways



Previous Scope Modifications



- Retaining wall and foundation structural system changes
- Instead of raising floor in old boiler room, ramp down to the fitness center and dance studio
- Relocate some of the vehicle lifts and equipment from Abrookin for CTE programs
- Eliminate the dedicated elevator from the stage to the lower level
- Modify ceiling materials change from linear metal ceilings to acoustical panel ceilings
- Provide more economical auditorium seats
- Eliminate the indoor track since the district now has one at North Albany Middle School
- Defer fit out of TV studio to Phase 4
- Total Estimated Savings Approximately \$11 million



Descoping Process



- What is it?
 - Meeting with the contractors to make sure that they have the scope of work covered.
 - Discussing what they see in the job that could be modified to save costs.
 - In addition to contractor suggestions, the project team has added other items.





- Sitework
 - Items Proposed to Accept
 - Redesign landscaping
 - Remove temporary flagpole (done by district)
 - Exterior guardrail change from stainless steel to powder coat
 - Change bollards from stainless steel to steel with plastic cover
 - Change architectural privacy fence to chain link fence with privacy strips
 - Remove masonry from planter wall
 - Revise concrete walks
 - Potential savings \$170,000



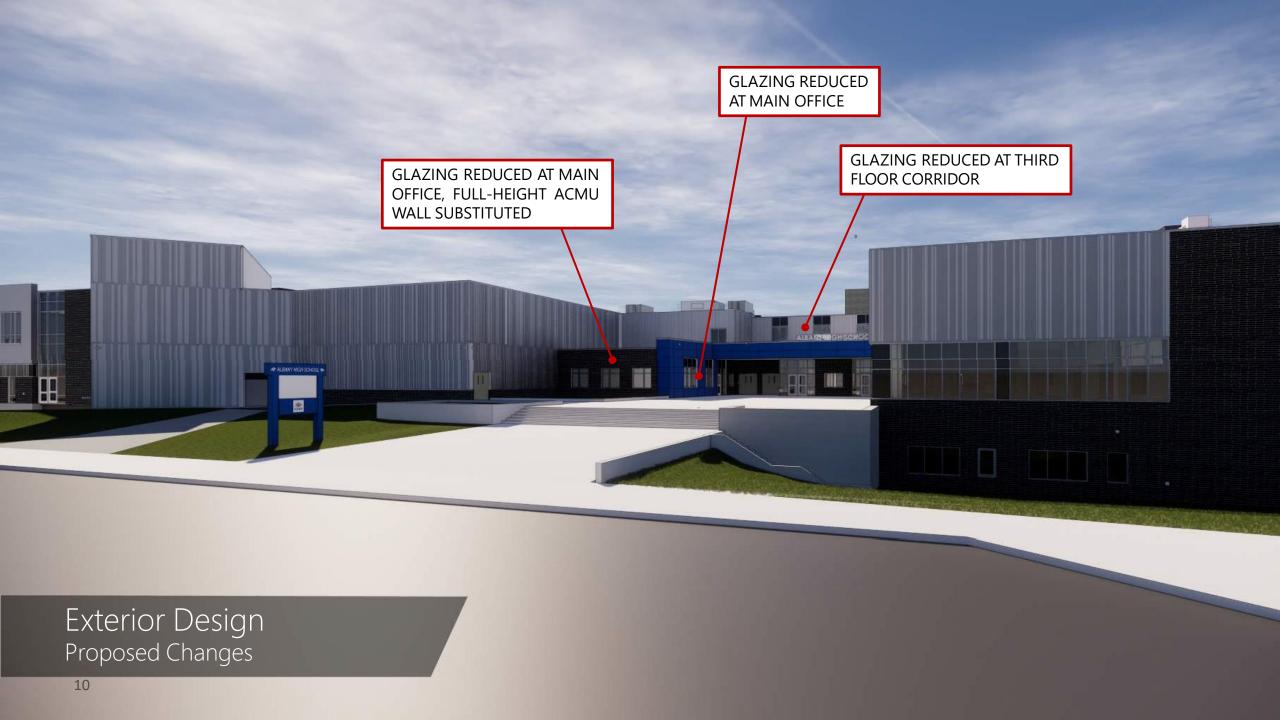


- General Construction
 - Items for Discussion/More Information
 - Modify exterior glazing
 - Reduce ceiling acoustical panels in Building Trades and Auto
 - Change finish materials details in the media center
 - Change size of porcelain floor tile form 24"x48" to 12"x24"
 - Reduce glazing sizes in main lobby
 - Eliminate all sidelights to classroom doors
 - Items Proposed to Accept
 - Eliminate sidelights in 2-hour rated walls in CTE
 - Change specification on physical education flooring
 - Eliminate furring system behind masonry veneer (not required)
 - Alternative furring system behind exterior metal panels
 - Change manufacturer of vehicle lifts to Rotary (matches existing)
 - Delete cleaning at substantial completion
 - Change density of spray fire proofing (harder finish not required)
 - Potential Savings

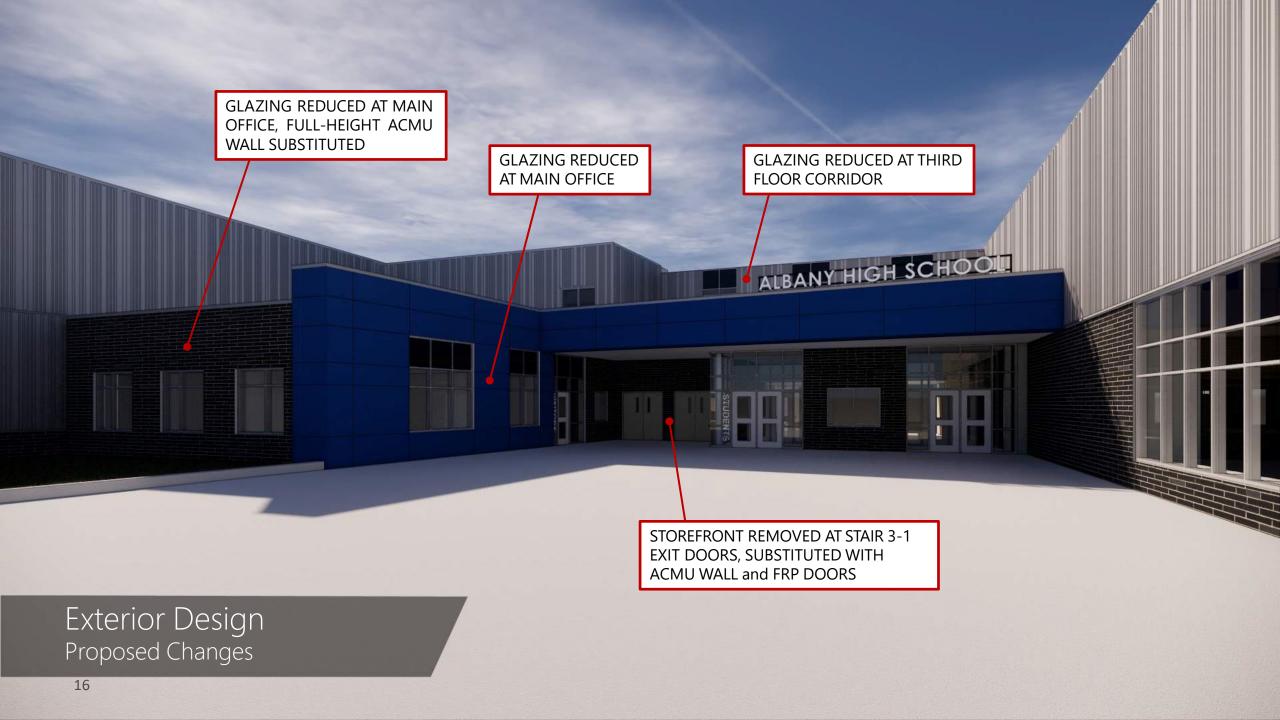

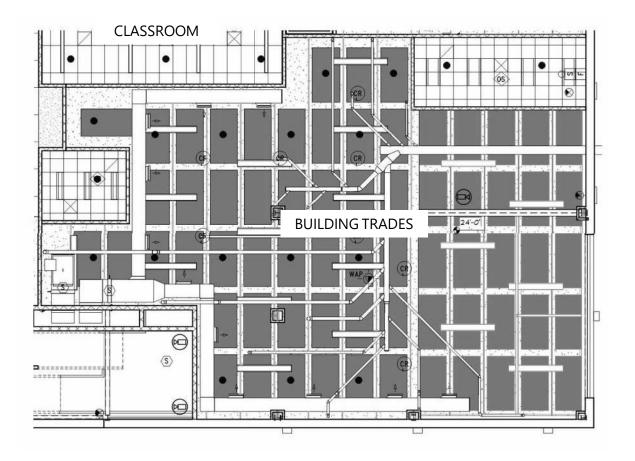
CURRENT ACOUSTIC PANEL LAYOUT

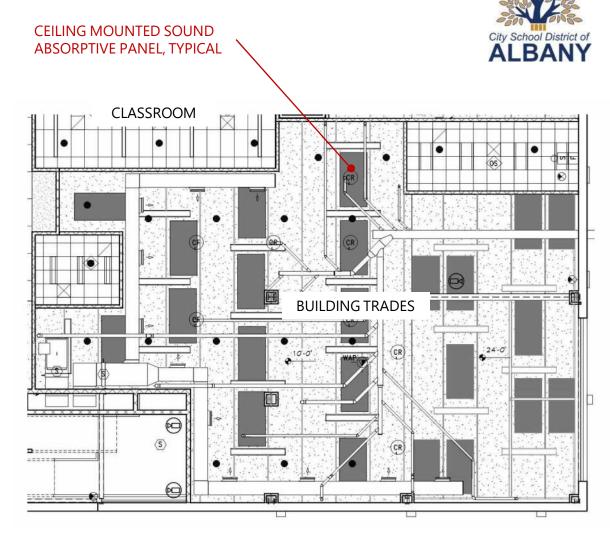


PROPOSED ACOUSTIC PANEL LAYOUT



CTE Building Trades RCPs





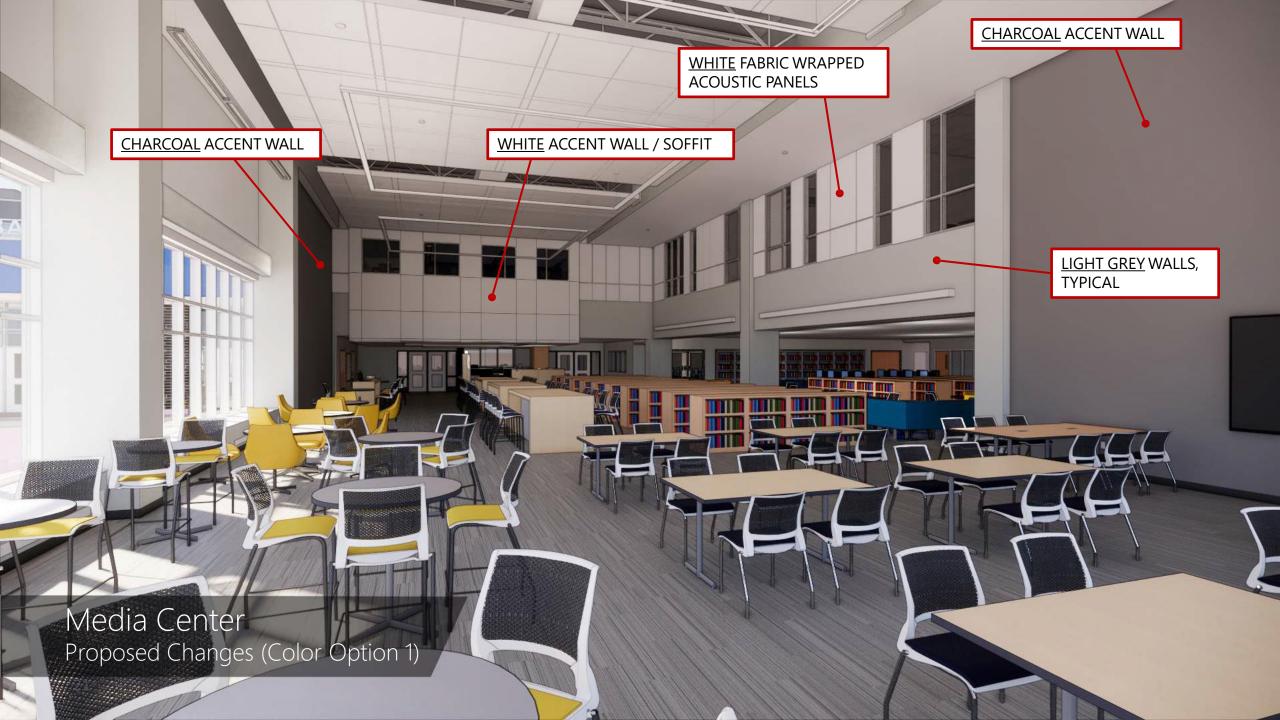
CURRENT ACOUSTIC PANEL LAYOUT

 - Items for Discussion
 - Change factory double wall insulated exterior ductwork to field insulated
 - Potential Savings

\$0 - \$65,000

- Electrical
 - Items for More Information
 - Modified auditorium sound system functions and equipment
 - Lighting fixture specification changes
 - Systems cabling exposed on hooks above suspended ceilings
 - Items Proposed to Accept
 - Modify technology cabling to updated district standard
 - Potential Savings

\$15,000 - \$151,000





- Phase 4
 - Align scope of exterior track work to pre-referendum scope of resurfacing
 - Align scope of concession stand and turf field entrance to pre-referendum scope
 - Potential budget transfer to Phase 3

\$680,000

- Multivista Photo Documentation
 - Stop documentation after Phase 2
 - Potential savings

•	Phase 1 Contingency Release	\$ 75,000
•	Phase 4 Budget Reduction	\$ 680,000
•	Multivista Reduction	\$ 132,000
•	Total Potential Reductions	\$2,284,450
•	Current Bid Over Original Estimate	\$ 1,986,000
•	Net Potential Overage	\$(298,450)
