Principal's Message

Welcome back to school! It is hard to believe the first five weeks have come and gone so quickly. Since we have reached the half-way point of the first marking period, it is time to talk specifics about your child. Enclosed is your child's first quarter interim report. Review the interim report, and if you have any questions or concerns, contact your child's guidance counselor at (518) 475-6486.

As you know, we use **student photo ID** cards for access to lunch and bus privileges for those students eligible to receive free transportation. All students should have received their ID cards and should be wearing them around their necks during the school day. Replacement cards due to loss or theft will have a \$5 replacement fee. Your child should report to the main

office if they have not been issued an ID or if their card does not have a photo.

Hackett's annual **Open House** took place on Sept. 29. We would like to thank all parents and guardians who attended and participated.

On Oct. 7, the annual test of City School District of Albany's Early Dismissal Plan was carried out. Each year the State Education Department requires this test for all schools. All students were released 15 minutes earlier than their normally scheduled time in order to test the early dismissal response procedures of our emergency management plan.

In an effort to broaden access to parent-teacher conferences by our families, we will hold **two parent-**

teacher conference days on Oct. 28 and Feb. 10 and offer both daytime and early evening sessions to families. Early evening appointments will be held on Thursday, Oct. 27 from 4-7 p.m., while Friday, October 28 will offer morning appointments from 8-11 a.m. Please note that Wednesday, Nov. 23 is now a recess day for all students and staff.

Hackett's **Picture Day** will take place Oct. 19-Oct. 20, with all students being professionally photographed by Lifetouch Studios during their physical education classes. Oct. 19 will be a "Day 1" and Oct. 20 will be a "Day 2." An information flyer was previously sent home.
